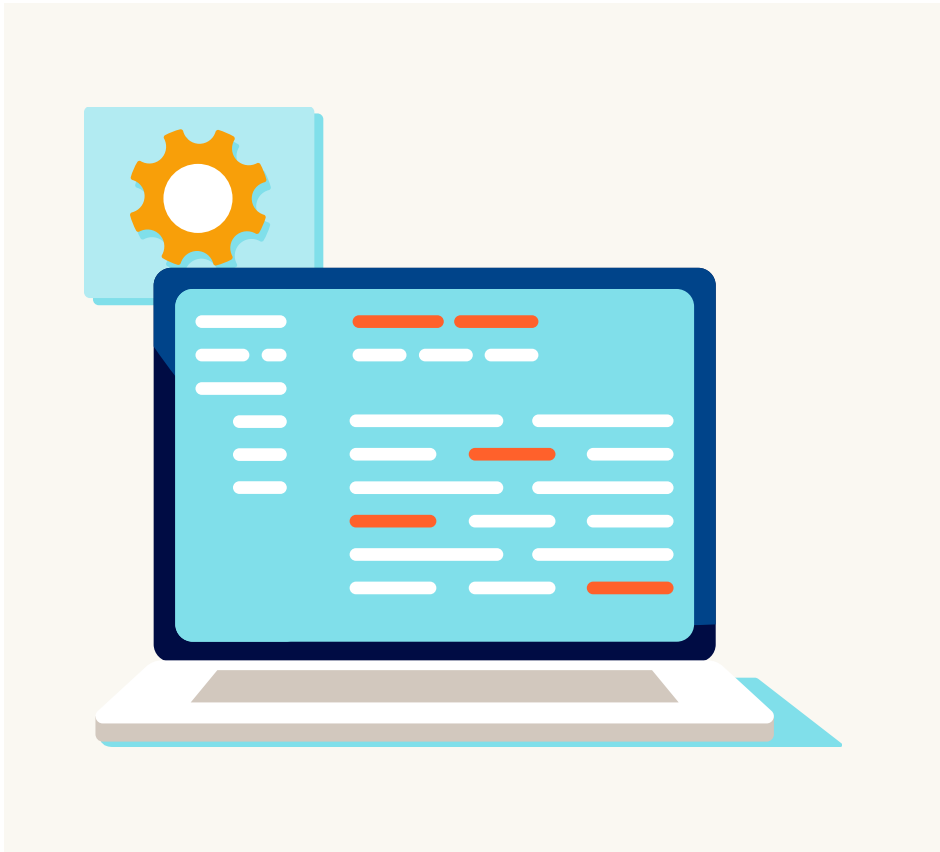

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HCC Now – Setting the foundation



- Identify HCC Codes Immediately
- For any HCC code, determine the HCC category for ANY model (CMS, PACE/ESRD, RX, or even HHS Commercial HCC)
- Access **all** codes in ANY model (CMS, PACE/ESRD, RX, HHS Commercial) for the past 4 years
- Identify the hierarchy information for each category in each model
- Identify specific CDI content for **each** code in any model from 4 different sources of content

Types of edits and examples...

Types of Edits

- Positive and negative edits.
 - Code guidelines can affect edits.
 - Edit messages supported by clinical documentation.
1. Amputations-E11.5, I73
 - a. Pt with Vascular disorders indicated, please verify there are no amputations within the past medical history. If Amputations are found, please code Z90.XX to Z90.XX
 2. Arrhythmias/AFIB (I48 series.)-presence of pacer(z95.0)
 - a. Pt with Arrhythmia coded today. Please review the record for any indication of a pacemaker or defibrillator today
 3. Dementia- F03.9X-
 - a. Suggest F01-5, F02.8- Don't forget the code first note
 - b. Pt with Unspecified dementia coded. Please verify there a more specified dementia is not listed within the medical record. If the patient has a more specific type of dementia in the medical record. Please code to the highest specificity. F01.5x-F02.80
 - c. If F02.80 used. Please be sure to code **first** the etiology of the dementia.
 - a. Top 5 most common etiologies
 - a. G31.83
 - b. G30
 - c. G20
 - d. B20
 - a. Clinical indications in note? Signs and symptoms?

<p>NOTE Functional activity All neoplasms are classified in this chapter, whether they are functionally active or not. An additional code from Chapter 4 may be used, to identify functional activity associated with any neoplasm.</p> <p>Morphology [Histology] Chapter 2 classifies neoplasms primarily by site (topography), with broad groupings for behavior, malignant, in situ, benign, etc. The Table of Neoplasms should be used to identify the correct topography code. In a few cases, such as for malignant melanoma and certain neuroendocrine tumors, the morphology (histologic type) is included in the category and codes.</p> <p>Primary malignant neoplasms overlapping site boundaries A primary malignant neoplasm that overlaps two or more contiguous (next to each other) sites should be classified to the subcategory/code .8 ("overlapping lesion"), unless the combination is specifically indexed elsewhere.
